- Follow up with organisations that interest you by contacting them e.g. about work experience opportunities or open events.

- What's the best way to contact you?



Employers:

- What does your company look for in potential employees?
- What could I do now to help me get a job with you in the future?
- What's the best thing about working for your company?
- Do you offer apprenticeships, work experience or work placements? What roles are they and how do I apply?

Education & training providers:

- What courses do you offer?
- How do I apply for a course?
- What qualifications will I need?
- Do you have an open event that I could come to?
