4.	Special Recognition Award	Apprentices at any level who have achieved in overcoming significant challenges or barriers to learning or work
5.	Rising Star Award	Individuals who have made outstanding progress and had a significant impact in the first 9 months of their apprenticeship
6.	Shining Star Award	Individuals who have made outstanding progress in their career since <b>completing their first apprenticeship</b> and have potential to achieve more
7.	Apprenticeship Ambassador Award	Apprentices / former apprentices at <b>any level</b> who have demonstrated a commitment to promoting apprenticeships and gone above and beyond expectations
8.	Oxfordshire Apprentice of the Year (chosen by headline sponsor)	The apprentice who has reached the highest levels of excellence and achievement. Chosen by the headline sponsor with the support of the Awards Committee from the winners of the five apprentice award categories

9.	Apprenticeship Employer of the Year Award (<250 employees)	Small and medium sized apprenticeship employers in Oxfordshire that have exceeded normal standards and expectations in providing a high-quality apprenticeship experience
10.	Apprenticeship Employer of the Year Award (250+ employees)	Large apprenticeship employers in Oxfordshire that have exceeded normal standards and expectations in providing a high-quality apprenticeship experience
11.	Inspiring the Future Employer of the Year Award	Employers in Oxfordshire that have exceeded normal standards and expectations to <b>inspire the next generation</b> e.g. engaging with local schools and colleges and providing work / T Level placements
