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

### Year 11 Leavers at Risk of NEET

#### Link to referral form

The Oxfordshire County Council Education, Employment & Training team are offering one to one support for any Year 11 school leaver without a destination for September 2023. This early intervention offer, that they put in place as a result of the pandemic in 2020, has proved positive in ensuring a student is known to them and over the summer holidays they will help them to secure provision for Year 12. Their one to one work is a voluntary offer and they do need the consent of the young person. Their statutory responsibility in line with Raising the Participation Age starts in September 2023 when they have a duty to track all school leavers and offer support.

For the third year running, Highways and Construction Work Experience Week will be going ahead. The week will be on **Monday 10th July to Friday 14th July**.

The week's placement is to plan, cost and design part of a new road in England. Over the week, students will meet a variety of people who work in construction and engineering, learning about their jobs and their route into construction. They come from a wide variety of backgrounds and their paths into their current job have not always been what you might expect. They will also meet recruitment experts to give them hints and tips on CVs and interviews.

There are two options for students to be involved in the week:

- Virtual delivery: students take part in Highways and Construction Work Experience week via Zoom
- In person delivery: if there is a site near to you that has availability, students will be able to visit a site for the week

Students can register their interest by completing a short form and task.

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
