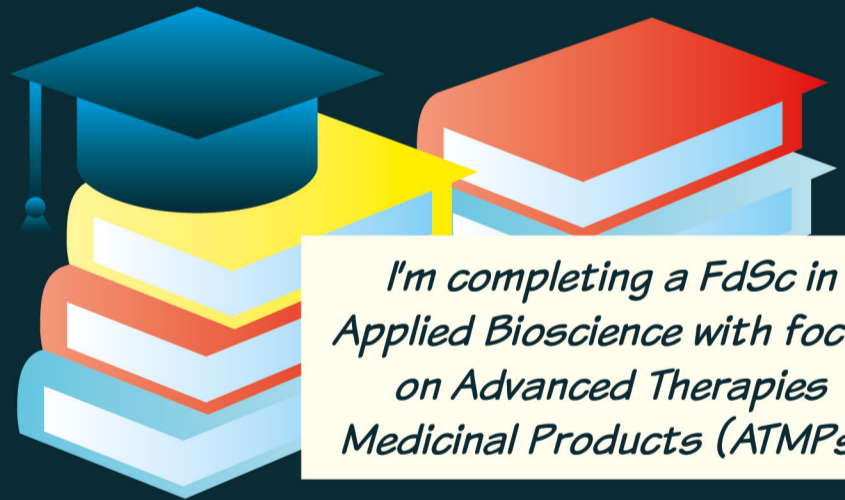


In the Clinical BioManufacturing Facility we manufacture Investigational Medicinal Products (IMPs) for early phase clinical trials, following good manufacturing practice.
