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

Oxfordshire County Council has a new Apprenticeship Hub which is managing the apprenticeship opportunities within the Council. Recognising that work experience can be a great introduction to the working world from next year, the team will also oversee all work experience opportunities. Until now, work experience has been offered on an ad-hoc, reactive basis within different departments. 


