Trinity College, University of Oxford are offering a free CPD programme starting in **January 2023** for teachers from state schools. The programme aims to provide up to date, practical information and guidance relating to the University of Oxford application process and the purpose of each stage, for example, the admissions tests and interviews, to help them better advise students.

It also has the broader aim of providing teachers with guidance that may help them to support students in all higher education applications, as well as those who may have the potential to apply to Oxford.

The programme takes place online and is made up of 6 x 1.5 hour live sessions, each taking place after the school day. Although the programme starts in January, they encourage teachers to join at any point or just for those sessions they would find most helpful. They offer a completion certificate for those attending all sessions, however there is no requirement to do so.


