## **Oxfordshire Creative Industries Showcase 2022**

**Teachers and 6th form students** are invited to attend this event on **21st June from 10:00 to 16:30** at Brookes. There will be a special panel session for education professionals covering careers in the creative industry. Please ask Heads of Curriculum in departments such as English, Art and Technology to share this invitation with teachers and 6th form students.

In 2019, the last year before COVID-19 struck, the creative sector was growing at four times the rate of the UK economy as a whole and generating new jobs at three times the UK average, employing two million people and accounting for almost one-in-eight of all UK businesses.

Oxford and Oxfordshire – with its rich heritage of classic stories and storytellers, from Lewis Carroll, Tolkien and CS Lewis to Philip Pullman and Iris Murdoch – as well as the pioneering work of its universities in VR and new digital technologies, is in a position to make a unique contribution to the UK's creative sector. The breadth of creativity, talent and innovation in our county is inspiring.

The Oxfordshire Creative Industries Showcase 2022 will bring together innovators, local and national businesses, entrepreneurs, national sector bodies and representatives, industry leaders and influencers to continue to champion the creative industries in Oxfordshire at a local, national and international level.

'Celebrating Oxfordshire's role in the UK's creative economy'. It will also engage teachers and school leaders to highlight the potential of future careers for Oxfordshire's young people in the creative industries. The day will focus on a series of panel sessions curated by key partners; Oxford Brookes University, University of Oxford TORCH and OxLEP.

## **Oxfordshire Advanced Skills Roadshow**

The Oxfordshire Advanced Skills Roadshow is now taking enquiries for bookings for **September 2022 onwards**. The OAS Roadshow is essentially a visit from OAS (a science and engineering apprenticeship provider based in Culham) to demonstrate several interesting experiments and activities that people can engage with. This might be mapping something to be produced by a 3D printer or coding a robotic hand to move and pick something up – this has been set up with a view to inspire people to consider a career in science and engineering.

OAS are particularly hoping to engage with those people that might not view it as a viable career path or even know it exists. By doing so OAS is attempting to make their programmes more accessible and gain strength through diversity. They hope to clarify what being an engineer can look like, the routes to becoming an engineer and the relative benefits of each. Their target engagement group is **Year 9 and above**.


