

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
The Big Bang Competition

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want to work in the NHS. The Cadetship takes the form of a Level 3 Senior Health Care Support Worker Apprenticeship. Cadets are employed by the Trust on a 22 month Fixed Term Contract, so it's a great way to earn as you learn - gaining nationally recognised qualifications and building a wealth of practical experience working alongside experienced colleagues.

Cadets work full time (37.5 hours) - split between study (7.5 hours per week) and clinical shifts working on a Ward at a Community Hospital (30 hours per week) - these are worked on a rota, so shifts might start from 7am and include weekend working.

The programme is designed with career progression in mind. Successful Nurse Cadets - upon completing their apprenticeship - are guaranteed an interview for a range of further development opportunities according to their interests:

- 1. Interview to join the Trust as a Band 3 Health Care Support Worker
